

HAVE YOU LOST IMPORTANT GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS IN NEED OF REPLACEMENT?

The County of Santa Barbara Clerk-Recorder is prepared to provide expedited replacement copies of vital and official records for the people who lost or sustained damage to their homes, property, businesses or places of employment during the proclaimed State of Emergency Wildfires. These vital and official copies may include certificates of birth, death, fetal death, or marriage, as well as deeds required to obtain assistance from federal, state and local governmental agencies, make claims for and collect insurance, find new employment, and for other purposes related to losses suffered in the fire. Per the Governor's Executive Order S-15-08, copies of certificates of birth, death, fetal death, and marriage, shall be provided to such persons without charge.
