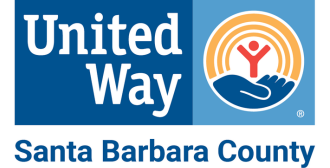


COVID-19 RESPONSE



\$27 million raised or managed by United Way to support local residents

\$5.6M RAISED

through the Joint Response Effort for Santa Barbara County to respond to community needs



\$18.2M MANAGED

in CARES Act, CDBG, & Treasury funds to provide rental/utility assistance and other services



\$7.2M DISTRIBUTED

in emergency individual, rental, & utilities assistance grants for local households



3,516 HOUSEHOLDS

have received individual, rental, & utilities assistance from United Way of Santa Barbara County



217 NONPROFITS

have received a total of \$3M in support grants from the Joint Response Effort



\$1.3M RAISED

for Learning & Enrichment Centers that provide 600+ students with in-person education support



\$685K RAISED

to provide emergency child care services for up to 278 children of local essential workers
